**Description of Network Changes Planned:**

**Frontier North, Inc.** announces that it intends to retire it’s Stromberg Carlson DCO Switch and associated remote wire centers listed below:

On or after December 1, 2022, the Bourbon, IN DCO switch, and associated remotes will be retired and removed from Frontier’s network as part of its ongoing efforts to modernize the network.

The Exchange Code (NXX) in Numbering Plan Area (NPA) 574 currently residing in the Bourbon, IN DCO switch and associated remotes (see list in Table B below) will be moved to the EKHTINXAPSO PEO virtual switch (see details in Table A below).



**Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:**

The native NPA NXX belonging to the Bourbon, IN DCO switch and associated remotes will be rehomed upon decommissioning of the switch and reflected in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) for the Elkhart, IN PEO switch. This will occur on or after December 1, 2022.

**Network Changes and Trunk Rearrangements:**

The Elkhart, IN PEO switch will be the recipient office of traffic migrated from the Bourbon, IN DCO switch and remotes. Traffic bound for the codes listed in Table B will be delivered via the Elkhart, IN Tandem (EKHTINXA15T Intra-Lata SHA/ EKHTINXA15T Inter-Lata FG Access SHA).

After all traffic is migrated off the Bourbon, IN DCO switch and associated remotes, they will be retired and removed from the network.



**Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes (cont.):**

CLECs, IXCs, IECs, wireless carriers and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Elkhart Tandem or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that have direct end office trunks (DEOT) with access connectivity in the Bourbon, IN DCO switch and remotes will be required to reposition the codes to the Elkhart Tandem switch.

All ASRs (Access Service Requests) for the Elkhart Tandem switch must be received no later than September 1, 2022, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. All traffic must be moved by October 1, 2022. All ASRs for the Elkhart Tandem switch must carry the project code of BRBNINXADSO.

Please adhere to industry standards using normal procedures that pertain to updates and changes to the LERG for all NXXs subject to the retirement of the Bourbon, IN DCO switch and remotes.
