**Description of Network Changes Planned:**

**Frontier Communications of California**– announces that it intends to retire its GTD5 switch from the wire center listed below:

On or after December 13, 2024, the Thousand Palms, CA GTD5 switch and associated remotes, will be retired and removed from the Frontier network as part of ongoing efforts to modernize the network.

The Exchange Codes (NXX) in Numbering Plan Area (NPA) 760 currently residing in the Thousand Palms, CA GTD5 switch and associated remotes (see list in Table B below) will be moved to the SNMNCAXPPSO PEO virtual switch (see details in Table A below).



**Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:**

The native NPA NXX belonging to the Thousand Palms, CA GTD5 switch and associated remotes, will be rehomed upon decommissioning of the switch and reflected in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) for the Santa Monica, CA PEO switch. This will occur on or after December 13, 2024.

**Network Changes and Trunk Rearrangements:**

The Santa Monica, CA PEO switch will be the recipient office of traffic migrated from the Thousand Palms, CA GTD5 switch and associated remotes. Traffic bound for the codes listed in Table B will be delivered via the Palm Springs, CA Tandem (PLSPCAXG88T Intra-Lata SHA/ PLSPCAXG88T Inter-Lata FG Access SHA).

After all traffic is migrated off the Thousand Palms, CA GTD5 switch and remotes, it will be retired and removed from the network.



**Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes (cont.):**

CLECs, IXCs, IECs, wireless carriers and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Palm Springs Tandem or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that have direct end office trunks (DEOT) with access connectivity in the Thousand Palms, CA GTD5 switch and remotes, will be required to reposition the codes to the Palm Springs Tandem switch.

All ASRs (Access Service Requests) for the Palm Springs Tandem switch must be received no later than November 15, 2024, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. All traffic must be moved by November 29, 2024. All ASRs for the Palm Springs Tandem switch must carry the project code of THPLCAXFDS0.

Please adhere to industry standards using normal procedures that pertain to updates and changes to the LERG for all NXXs subject to the retirement of the Thousand Palms, CA GTD5 switch and remotes.
