Description of Network Changes Planned:

CITIZENS TEL CO OF WV DBA FRONTIER OF WV- announces that it intends to retire it's Stromberg Carlson DCO Switch from the wire center listed below:

On or after May 1, 2025, the Cowen, WV DCO switch will be retired and removed from the Frontier network as part of ongoing efforts to modernize the network.

The Exchange Codes (NXX) in Numbering Plan Area (NPA) 304 currently residing in the COWNWVXADS0 DCO switch and associated remotes (see list in Table B below) will be moved to the COWNWVXARPO PEO virtual switch (see details in Table A below).



Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:

The native NPA NXX belonging to the Cowen, WV DCO Host switch will be rehomed upon decommissioning of the switch and reflected in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) for the Clarksburg, WV PEO switch. This will occur on or after May 1, 2025.

Network Changes and Trunk Rearrangements:

The Clarksburg, WV PEO switch will be the recipient office of traffic migrated from the Cowen, WV DCO host switch. Traffic bound for the codes listed in Table B will be delivered via the Clarksburg, WV Tandem (CLBGWVMA26T) Intra-Lata SHA/ (CLBGWVMA26T) inter-Lata FG Access SHA).

After all traffic is migrated off the Cowen, WV DCO host switch, it will be retired and removed from the network.



Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes (cont.):

CLECs, IXCs, IECs, wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Clarksburg, WV (CLBGWVMA26T) Tandem or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that have direct end office trunks (DEOT) with access connectivity in the Cowen, WV DCO switch will be required to reposition the codes to the CLBGWVMA26T Tandem switch.

All ASRs (Access Service Requests) for the Clarksburg (CLBGWVMA26T) Tandem switch must be received no later than March 1, 2025, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. All traffic must be moved by April 15, 2025. All ASRs for the Clarksburg (CLBGWVMA26T) Tandem switch must carry the project code of **COWNWVXADS0**.

Please adhere to industry standards using normal procedures that pertain to updates and changes to the LERG for all NXXs subject to the retirement of the Cowen, WV DCO switch.
