**Registration to speak at a public input hearing is encouraged but not required:** If you wish to testify, you are encouraged to pre-register with the Office of Administrative Law Judge (OALJ). Those who pre-register and provide the information listed below will be called to testify at the hearing in the order in which they pre-register. If you want to listen to a public input hearing (without testifying), you do not need to pre-register.

**REQUESTS FOR INTERPRETERS:** If you require an interpreter, please pre-register as soon as possible. If you register too close to the hearing date, we may not have enough time to arrange for an interpreter. If you request an interpreter, the PUC will make reasonable efforts to have one present.
